RPA loses farmers’ bank data

Thousands of farmers’ bank account details have been lost by the Rural Payments Agency (RPA) after two back-up tapes of confidential data went missing.

The lost data pertained to all farmers who have ever claimed a single farm payment. Computer tapes containing the bank details, addresses, passwords and security questions of more than 100,000 farmers were discovered missing in May, at which point the Department of Environ-

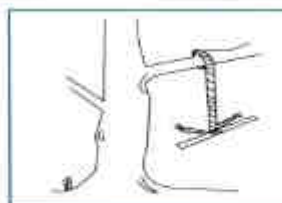
point the Department of Environment Food and Rural Affairs (Defra) was alerted.

The RPA, which administers the single payment system of EU subsidies to English farmers for Defra, was criticised last week by the National Audit Office for its handling of the scheme.

The RPA, which blames the loss on contractor IBM, discovered the problem in September, but neither the agency nor Defra has attempted to inform farmers about the breach. ●

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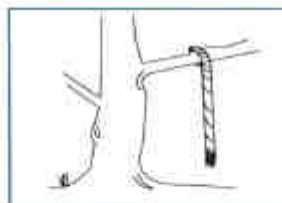
